Track Rules

- 1. Verbal/physical abuse towards anyone on the facility grounds will not be tolerated and will result in removal from the premises. Zero tolerance.
- 2. Racer gates are open from 8:30 am to 11:00 pm
- 3. Wristbands must be worn at all times.
- 4. Drivers of any motorized vehicles must be licensed (except junior dragsters)
- 5. All children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 6. Speed limit in the pit area is 10km/hr.
- 7. All running vehicles must have a driver in the driver's seat.
- 8. When testing a running car in the pits (running in gear) the vehicle must be supported by two stands placed on plywood with a driver in the seat.
- 9. Absolutely no motorized vehicles on the track except for racers and track staff during the races.
- 10. All race vehicles must have current year TECH sticker.
- 11.Only timing staff are permitted in the timing bus at any time. All concerns will be handled by the Race Captain or 2 executive members.
- 12.All race vehicles must have proper restraints, this includes driver and passengers.
- 13. All driver and passengers will wear the appropriate race attire as per the WDRA rule book.
- 14. Electronic devices are allowed in the Box category only.
- 15. No Burn outs or stunting in pits, camping area or parking. This will result in removal from the facility.
- 16. No Passengers permitted during the elimination rounds.
- 17. No riding allowed on the outside of a vehicle, hanging off or on the tailgate.
- 18. Dial in and Car numbers must be displayed on the top right windshield and on the passenger's side widow in bold white letters/numbers. (Except juniors and dragsters)
- 19.If you are deep staging, rolling burn out, time only must be marked on the windshield.
- 20. All windows must be closed during staging.

- 21.Gentlemen staging in effect (wait for opponent to pre stage before full staging)
- 22. No holding vehicles during burnouts
- 23. Backing up after burnout is only permitted to straighten your vehicle or in the case of a rolling burn out.
- 24.Laddered pairs are picked by computer, if computer not available random matches will be used.
- 25. Only one bye per event. Bye runs must be taken.
- 26. Crossing the center line will result in an automatic disqualification.
- 27. Lane choice is picked by the computer, if no computer it will be the drivers decision. If the drivers can not decide on lanes a coin toss will take place.
- 28. The qualification runs allotted will depend on the number of vehicles and time permitting. A maximum of three qualification runs per race day.
- 29. Proceed to return lane and pits promptly. Using the return lane only
- 30. A complete stop must be done before receiving the time slip.
- 31.Entry fees will be refunded only if no runs were made. If you trip the lights, it is considered a run.
- 32. Grassed areas can be very dry, be aware of fire hazards.
- 33. Quite time in the pits/camping is at 11:00 pm. Generators cannot run all night.
- 34. Pets are allowed in the pits camping area but must be leashed and contained to your pit only.
- 35. Any pets being walked must be on a non-retractable leash only. You must clean up after your pet.
- 36. Smoking is permitted in the pit/camping area and other designated areas only. Dispose of your smoking material in a proper receptacle.
- 37. No intoxicates are to be used while the tree is up.
- 38. No persons under the age of 16 can operate any wheeled vehicles while the tree is up (except the junior dragsters)
- 39. The number of people in a golf cart/ pit vehicle should not exceed the number of seats in the vehicle,
- 40.All races will fall under the WDRA rule book.
- 41. When leaving the facility please drive the speed limit, refrain from stunting, squealing tires etc. We have neighbors too.
